

ACCOMMODATION

Northampton School will benefit from outstanding new accommodation when it moves onto its permanent site. This is due to be completed by the end of April 2024. The facilities will be state of the art including specialist areas for Sport, Performing Arts including Music, Design and Technology, Art, Science and Computer Science. All classrooms will be airconditioned and staff will connect to the teaching screens using their school provided Surface Pro Device.

By being based on the NSB site this year, students have been able to gain access to many of the specialist facilities that would otherwise be temporarily unavailable during the build process. When we move to the new site, full-time teachers will predominantly be based in their own classrooms.

Alongside the Trust benefits and excellent new teaching spaces there will be ample free staff parking on the site.
